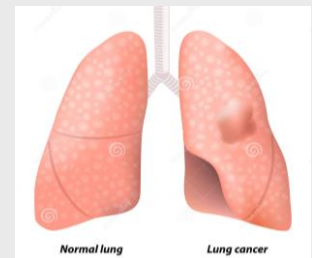

## Combinatorial Treatment Using Targeted MEK and SRC Inhibitors Synergistically Abrogates Tumor Cell Growth and Induces Mesenchymal-Epithelial Transition in Non-Small-Cell Lung Carcinoma. (*Oncotarget*, August 2015)

A study led by Associate Professor Goh Boon Cher and his team demonstrated that the co-inhibition of the MAPK and SRC pathways using specific inhibitors combination can stop tumor growth in NSCLC.

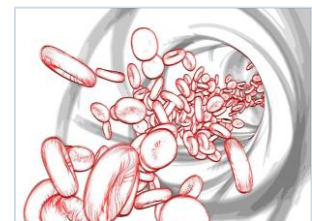
